Dear Parents & Carers,

Food and Farming Schools Day, Driffield, Wednesday 20th May

Our KS2 pupils have been invited to take part in an event at the Driffield Show Ground on Wednesday 20th May. This free event, organised by the Driffield Agricultural Society, gives a chance for everyone to enjoy and learn about the countryside including the roles that people play in our food production.

This will be a day of **action** and **hands on activities** aimed at giving a closer understanding of where food comes from and the roles of people involved in the production. There will be displays and activities all manned by real farmers and food producers who will be keen to inform and involve the children.

As this event involves hands-on activities, we politely ask that all children's medical information is up-to-date, including listing any allergies. Children will be handling several items during the day and will come into contact with different grains and oils, as well as be in proximity to dogs and livestock. Please email the school email address with any updates to our records, including updated contact information to reach you in case of an emergency. In addition to this, the event will be outside all day so any hay fever medication should be administered prior to the beginning of the school day.

We have funding towards transport for this event so there will be no charge for attendance which will be by coach. We will be leaving school at 9.30am and will return at approximately 2:30pm so children should attend school as normal at 8:40am and will be ready to collect as usual at 3:30pm. Children need to wear school uniform and have sensible shoes/boots for the day. Depending on the weather, children should also bring a raincoat or sun cream and sun hat.

As we are outside all day, children will need to bring a packed lunch and drinks bottle (no glass bottles, fizzy drinks or sweets please).

There is an option to purchase an ice-cream at a cost of £1.75. If your child would like an ice-cream, please make a payment on ParentPay.

Driffield Agricultural Society would like permission for photographs/videos to be taken of the children. The consent for this is on ParentPay.

Please can all consents and payment for an ice-cream, if required, be made on ParentPay by Friday 8th May at the latest.
